JOIN US FOR 14 FANTASTIC DAYS ON THE BEAUTIFUL ISLAND OF MAURITIUS TO FISH THE SUNSET BILLFISH CHALLENGE.

The 3rd Sunset Billfish Challenge was fished out of Black River in February 2005, and once again we were fortunate with the weather conditions and the fishing. There were 60 strikes reported resulting in 26 Billfish being tagged and released, these consisted of 20 Blue Marlin, 2 Black Marlin, 2 Spearfish and 2 Sailfish. This was a great result and compares favourably to many of the top billfish tournaments worldwide considering the amount of boat days fished.

Top Angler was **Michael Jones** from the team 'New Venture' and second placed angler was **Tony Green**. Top Lady Angler was **Mary Batterby** from team 'Us Two'. Team winners were **Keith Ford** and **David Campbell** from team 'The Heavyweights' and the second placed team were **Regal 2** fished by **Charlie Brogden, Dan Wingrove** and **Daniel Cruz**.

Top Boat was 'Thalassa' skippered by **Elvis** and the second placed boat was 'Tora Tors II' skippered by **Curtis**.

Mauritius continues to produce excellent Marlin fishing, it is one of the few destinations in the world that produces Blue Marlin over the 1000lb mark, and the fact that most of the top tournaments held on the Island are now mandatory Tag and Release is spreading rapidly through the International Game Fishing fraternity.

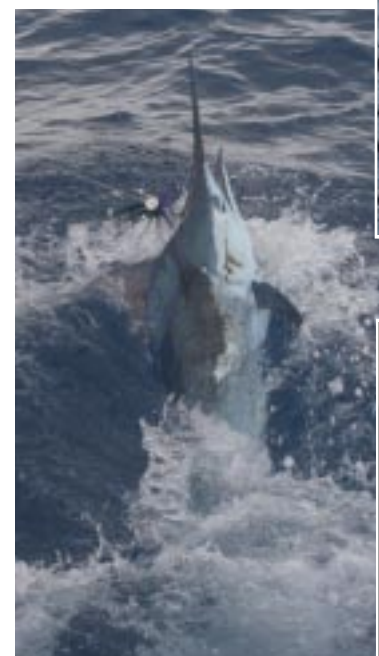
